



**Northbrook United Methodist Church
2021-2022 Mission Report**

Here is a snapshot of the mission work Northbrook has been able to do through the grace of God and the generosity of NUMC members.

Christmas Tree Sales for Kids:

- Raised \$50,000 in sales to support the work of Project Transformation and Murphy-Harpst Children's Centers

The Drake House:

- Sponsor and furnish two apartments for mothers and their children experiencing homelessness
- Members serve as parent and child advocates and financial coaches to help moms achieve their goals and move towards stability
- Donated \$11,987.90

Emergency Assistance Fund:

- Provided community members over \$13,000 in rental, mortgage, and utility assistance.
- 20 clients served from 2021-22

Esther Jackson Elementary School:

- 100 "thank you gifts" for faculty and staff
- Campus beautification – repainted crosswalks and laid 100 bales of pine straw
- Assembled 75 Blessing in a Backpack bags for students experiencing food insecurity
- 30 homeroom baskets for teachers
- Sunday school classes adopted seven families living in extended stay hotels for Christmas and provided gifts for children and their parents
- School supplies drive

Family Promise:

- Northbrook is a support congregation for Family Promise
- Members provide social support and nightly dinners for families, gas and grocery cards, and fund children's activities
- Donated \$4,489.90

Inspiritus:

- Provided coats and clothing for Afghan refugees experiencing their first winter
- Donated \$10,000 to assist refugees transitioning to the United States

Love Serve Guatemala Mission:

- Northbrook has sent 10 mission teams with approximately 90 members to Guatemala since 2014 to build and repair homes, provide VBS for children, and care for the people of Guatemala
- Youth Ministry raised money to provide 10 water filters to Guatemalan families
- Ministry was started by Northbrook members and missionaries Craig and Carol Hill

North Fulton Community Charities:

- Donated \$4,086.74

Trinity Table:

- Assembled 200 bags of non-perishable items
- Served a barbeque lunch to over 90 people experiencing homelessness
- 60 hygiene kits, including donated clothing, socks, and underwear

UMCOR Disaster Relief:

- Assembled 60 hygiene kits
- Served at the Disaster Relief Warehouse, inspecting supplies before transport
- Donated \$6,771.85

Total Funds Donated for Missions in 2021-22: \$100,336.39
